

Great America Band Field Trip

WHAT/WHERE? On Saturday, May 9th, 2015 the Dilworth intermediate band will perform in a band competition at a local school and spend the rest of the day at Great America. At the end of the day, students will attend an awards ceremony at Great America where their band will be presented with a trophy for their performance. This festival is put on by “Music in the Parks”, which has been in operation since 1980 and conducts these events in over 30 cities throughout America and Canada.

WHEN? Saturday, May 9th, 2015 approximately 9:30am-7:00pm.

Due to insurance reasons, each child’s parent will need to transport and supervise their child throughout this entire event.

PRICES There is a cost but the company offers some nice discounts. S’cool Spirit will subsidize most of the cost of one parent’s ticket to Great America so that the cost is only \$10.00 to each parent. Parents that take students to Great America will be responsible for parking fees. The prices are as follows:

Student plus parent attending both Competition and Great America - student AND parent both have a SEASON PASS to Great America (Student - \$27.00, plus parent - FREE) - plus parking	\$27.00
Student plus parent attending only Competition (Student - \$27.00, plus parent - FREE)	\$27.00
Student plus parent attending only Great America (no season passes) (Student - \$30.00, plus parent - \$10.00) - plus parking	\$40.00
